READ ME FIRST

The *El Dorado County Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (March 2012 Draft)* contains the individual *Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (Compatibility Plan)* for each of the three public-use airports within the jurisdiction of the El Dorado County Airport Land Use Commission:

- Cameron Airpark Airport
- Georgetown Airport
- Placerville Airport

Although the individual *Compatibility Plans* are bound into one document, the El Dorado County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) will take three individual actions to adopt the *Compatibility Plan* for each airport. As such, a Negative Declaration and Initial Study were prepared to present the potential environmental impacts of the proposed project for each airport pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

For your review, the contents of this submittal package include:

1. Notice of Intent (NOI) to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration – There is one NOI for each airport.
2. Negative Declaration and Initial Study – There is one Negative Declaration and Initial Study for each airport.
3. A copy of the El Dorado County Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (March 2012 Draft) plus addendum – Included as Attachment A.
